Reportable New Information (RNI) non-compliance decision matrix

The RNI process:

- A reportable new information report is submitted to the Animal Welfare Program (AWP).
- The RNI is reviewed by the AWP and the executive committee to determine if the RNI rises to the level of noncompliance as defined in AWP SOP I-IC-GU-103 Investigations of concerns involving animals
- If the RNI is NOT non-compliance then any corrective action items are determined by the executive committee and implemented by the AWP.
- If the RNI IS non-compliance then the RNI is sent to the IACUC for review. The IACUC will determine if the RNI is either Minor or Serious SOP I-IC-GU-103
- Serious non-compliance require reporting as outlined in SOP I-IC-GU-115
